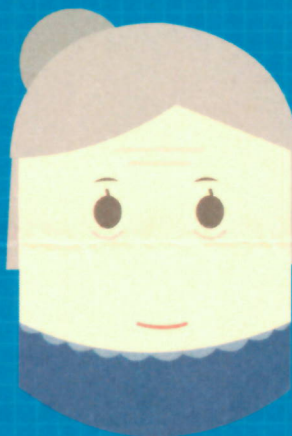
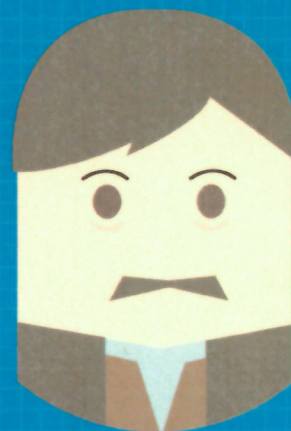

Eligibility Criteria

The United Way Hearing Aid Bank is a program of the John W. Keys Speech and Hearing Center on the OU Health Sciences Center campus. The program assists low income individuals in purchasing new, high-end, digital hearing aids at the reduced price of \$350 per hearing aid. Eligibility for this program includes:

- Meeting the salary qualifications as outlined in the below table
- Residing in one of the counties served by the Central Oklahoma United Way (Canadian, Cleveland, Kingfisher, Lincoln, Logan, Oklahoma, or Pottawatomie)
- Being at least 18 years of age or older
